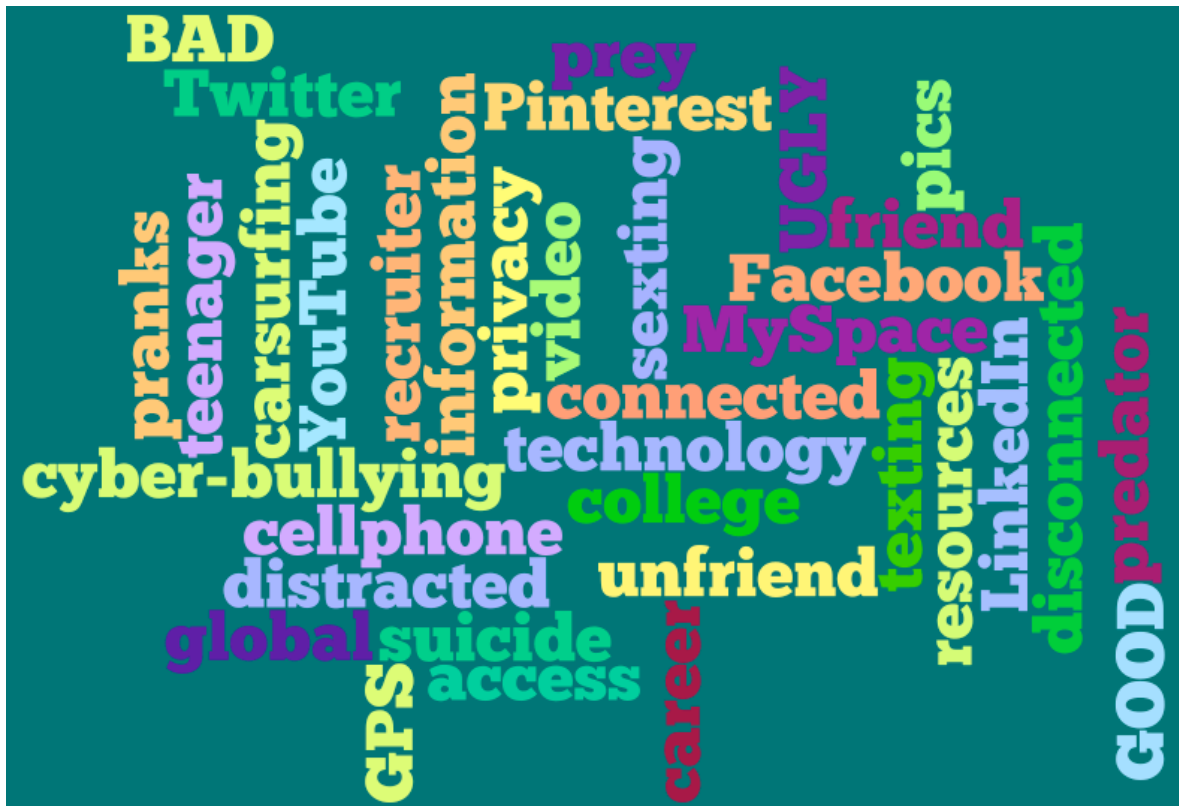




Technology: the Good, the Bad, and the Ugly
